IMPORTANT PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION DUE TO HURRICANE IAN

Anne M. Gannon, Constitutional Tax Collector serving Palm Beach County is very sensitive to the needs of citizens and property owners affected by the recent damage due to the Hurricane Ian; however, state law still requires the tax collector to mail and collect 2022 property tax bills.

Please read the important information below.

1. Property tax bills representing taxes assessed as of January 1, 2022 and are for the 2022 year have been mailed to property owners in Palm Beach County.
2. Florida Statute 197.333 states that property taxes are payable anytime between November 1 and March 31, 2023. Please keep in mind, there is no penalty for late payment until after March 31, 2023, and you do receive a discount if you pay early.
3. **However, due to Hurricane Ian the Governor’s Executive Order (EO) 22-242 provides for an extension of the November 4% discount period until January 31, 2023, as well as an extension of the March 31, 2023 payment deadline until May 31, 2023 if your property has been completely destroyed and/or is otherwise rendered uninhabitable. Please sign the statement below and return to the tax collector’s office if you believe your property qualifies for the extension.**
